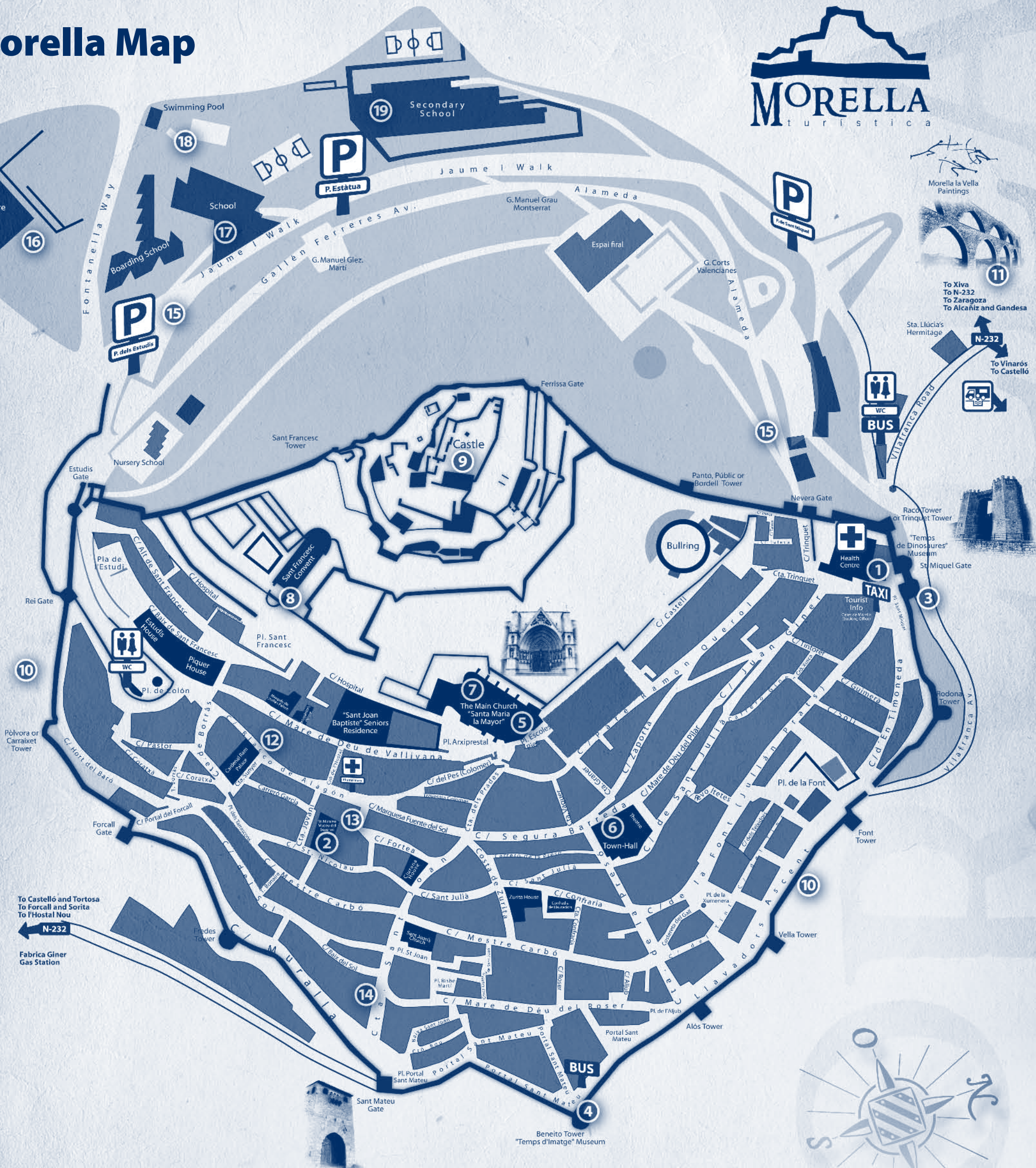


Morella Map

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MORELLA



To the north of the Valencian Community in the province of Castellón, the town of Morella stands up on a hill shaped like an inverted cone, surrounded by walls and its castle at the top. There are many singular buildings, important churches and streets that take the visitor back to the historic past of the town, especially to the medieval times which was its best period.

Its natural background, crafts, gastronomy and folklore are another attraction to this beautiful and unforgettable town, which has been awarded as "Conjunto Histórico-Artístico".

Sightseeing:

1 MUSEUM "TEMPS DE DINOSAURES": There are paleontological remains found in Morella, it is a must the figure of an Iguanodon as the dinosaur most present in the area.

2 MUSEUM "DESISENSIS": Its purpose is to make people know the most important festival in Morella, the "SEXENNI", which takes place every six years in honour of the Virgin of Vallivana since 1673.

OPENING HOURS: CHECK AT TOURIST INFO.

3 TOWERS OF SANT MIQUEL: Twin towers from the 15th century on an octagonal base linked at the top which are the most monumental entrance to the town.

4 MUSEUM "TEMPS D'IMATGE": This place tells the history of Morella through the images of the Pascual photographic collection.

OPENING HOURS: CHECK AT TOURIST INFO.

5 CHURCH MUSEUM: Located in the main church. It houses important jewellery, paintings and sculpture.

WINTER OPENING HOURS: FROM TUESDAY TO SATURDAY 11h-14h AND 16h-18h. SUNDAY 11h-14h. CLOSED ON MONDAY.

SUMMER OPENING HOURS: FROM MONDAY TO SUNDAY 11h-14h AND 16h-19h.

FEES: -SINGLE: 1,50€; -GROUPS: 1€ (+30 PEOPLE)

6 TOWN HALL: This gothic civil building has got the Europa Nostra award to the restoration, the two gothic halls are especially interesting (the council hall, the justice hall and the exchange hall).

7 THE MAIN CHURCH SANTA MARIA LA MAJOR: Splendid gothic religious building, it stands out the door of the Disciples with an elegant decoration and the door of the Virgins with a fine structure. Inside, the choir with its unique steps and the back of the choir, the main altar in baroque style and the pipe organ, which is considered the most important in the Valencian Community.

WINTER OPENING HOURS: FROM TUESDAY TO SUNDAY 11h-14h AND 16h-18h. SUNDAY 11h-14h. CLOSED ON MONDAY.

SUMMER OPENING HOURS: FROM MONDAY TO SUNDAY 11h-14h AND 16h-19h.

FEES: FREE.

8 CONVENT OF SANT FRANCESC: An old convent of Franciscan monks, it has got a church and a cloister of great beauty with arcs of great architectural beauty. In the room of De Profundis we find a true jewel of the death paintings: *The Dance of the Death*, which was restored a few years ago.

9 CASTLE: Military fortress placed on top of a rock which has witnessed many civilizations and many wars, all of them have left its mark on it. The outstanding view of the landscape you can see from the top of the castle is really remarkable.

WINTER OPENING HOURS: FROM MONDAY TO SUNDAY 11h-17h.

SUMMER OPENING HOURS: FROM MONDAY TO SUNDAY 11h-19h.

FEES: -SINGLE 3€

-DISCOUNT 2€

Other places to visit:

10 TOWERS AND WALLS: They surround the whole town along one mile. We can find 16 towers, from which the towers of Sant Miquel are the most beautiful; it is the main entry to the town.

11 AQUEDUCT: It was built in the 14th century. It is an extraordinary piece of civil engineering, nowadays two parts of it have been preserved; thanks to them we can appreciate how the water was carried to supply the local population.

12 BLASCO DE ALAGÓN HIGH STREET: It is known by the local people as "la plaça", it has got this name because it is the place where the local market occurs since the Middle Ages. The so called street has got an area with arcades which make it an original attraction.

13 THE JEWISH STREET: Small neighbourhood where the alleys and narrow streets are full of a special magic.

14 SANT JOAN STREET: It is not a street, in fact, it is a long series of steps, they cross the town from top to bottom, they are an original characteristic of the town.

ANCESTRAL HOMES: There are in Morella many noble houses which are the remains of the local

aristocracy. They have interesting facades, among them it is necessary to mention: the Ciurana House, the Piquer House, the present Cardenal Ram Hotel or the Marquis of Cruilles' House.

15 ALAMEDA PROMENADE: It is a natural area of great beauty, it is placed at the back of the town. There are two gates to access it from the town: the Nevera and the Estudis Gate. It is the favourite place to go for a walk in search of the sun in winter or the cool in the summer nights.

16 SPORTS CENTRE "JAUME I": A new offer for the sport and leisure which includes an indoor swimming pool.

EXTERIOR VISIT OF THE TOWN: Morella offers an unforgettable image as it is seen from the road N-232, which comes from the seaside; it is especially beautiful at night thanks to the monumental illumination.
